PERSONAL STATEMENT

I am a social–environmental scientist with an inter- and transdisciplinary profile, specialised in knowledge co-production to address complex socio-environmental challenges. My research integrates sustainability science, sociohydrology, environmental humanities, and human geography to examine sustainability transformations in contested or polarised contexts. I combine theoretical and methodological innovation with practical application, maintaining close engagement with policy processes, participatory approaches, and public institutions. My work is reflected in high-impact publications, international collaborations, caring mentorship, and direct contributions to governance, public engagement, and communication efforts.

During my early career period, my research contributed to expanding notions of coupled human–water systems, adaptive water governance, and the water–food–energy nexus, as well as to innovating methods through the integration of qualitative, quantitative, and participatory approaches in the science-for-governance framework Quantitative Storytelling. More recently, I shifted my research focus to knowledge co-production in so-called wicked environmental problems. Through an in-depth case study about the eutrophication of the Mar Menor lagoon (Murcia, Spain), I explored not only how and why polarisation emerges and hinders environmental action, but also how it can be transformed by becoming more attuned to differences and affects. This work has introduced innovative concepts such as polarisation traps, co-response-ability, relational transformation or bridging spaces, and proposed methodological pathways for transdisciplinary engagement in conflictive settings.

I participate in international research projects and networks on sustainability transformations, process-relational sustainability science, conflict and collaboration, and transdisciplinary research. I currently lead the Spanish team of the European project IntegrateNb, extending my research to the evaluation of transdisciplinary processes. I serve as Subject Editor for the Q1 journal *Ecology & Society*, landmark in sustainability science. I am a proud supervisor of the postdoctoral fellow Dr Violeta Furlan (IntegrateNbS), the PhD candidate Nicolás Gutiérrez (Basque Government grant), and the predoctoral fellow Irene Pérez Beltrán (Charlemagne Prize). All my publications, together with their associated datasets, are accessible in open access or preprint format through my website.

My work consistently emphasises societal relevance and public engagement. I have designed and facilitated more than 40 participatory research events. I served on the Coordination Panel of the Spanish Citizens' Assembly for Climate Change (2021–2022) and co-authored a Position Statement for the European Commission on the role of the Social Sciences and the Humanities in climate research. I have collaborated with water authorities and grassroots organisations in Spain and shared research findings with policymakers in Arizona, the Canary Islands, and the Mar Menor region. Currently, I engage Bilbao City Council and the Ebro Water District as partners in the IntegrateNbS project, exploring collaborative agenda setting and outcomes use for impact. Public dissemination is central to my practice, with outputs including outreach articles, arts-based publications, and media contributions. Overall, my work seeks to expand the possibilities of walking together towards more sustainable and just futures by bridging knowledge systems and societal divides in care-full democratic knowing, feeling and acting.
